Dear Clark County Republicans,

Democrats are gleefully anticipating the reversal of fifteen years of Republican gains in Clark County. They are encouraged by the meager Republican response in our recent Primary Election.

I believe that Republicans can pull the rug from under their anticipated win! However, it will require something from Clark County Republicans. **Here is what you can do:**
